Results of Questionnaires

A questionnaire was sent to every house on Plas Madoc Estate in November.

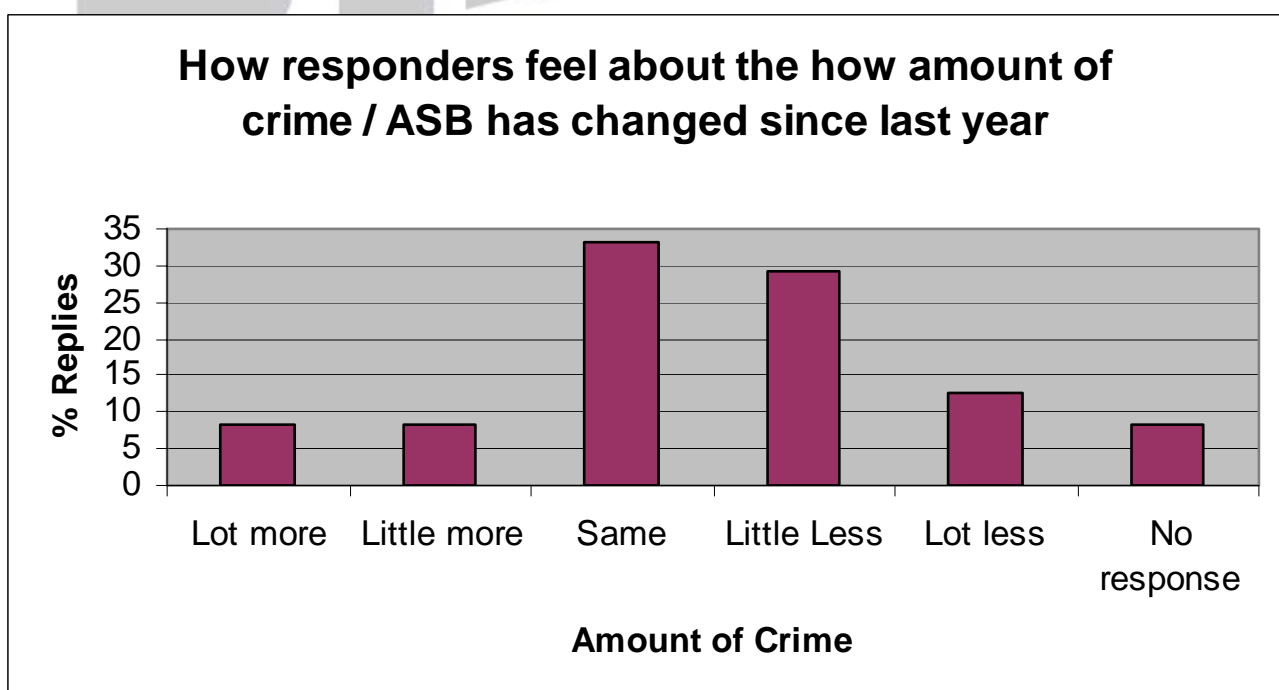
The Community Safety Group wanted to know what people felt were the main priorities that should be tackled to make living on the estate safer and better, in terms of quality of life. This is the second such exercise undertaken meaning that the 2005 / 2006 results can be taken as a baseline and this comparison is presented separately.

The results are as follows: -

Question 1: "Personal information"

- The majority of people who replied to the questionnaire had lived on the estate for between 2-5 yrs and also for between 5-10yrs.
- Although most age groups (10 yr brackets) were represented in the results, the largest group was ages 21 – 30, (which accounted for 40%).
- $\frac{3}{4}$ of the people who responded were female

Question 2: How do you think crime / antisocial behaviour on the estate has changed since the survey last autumn?

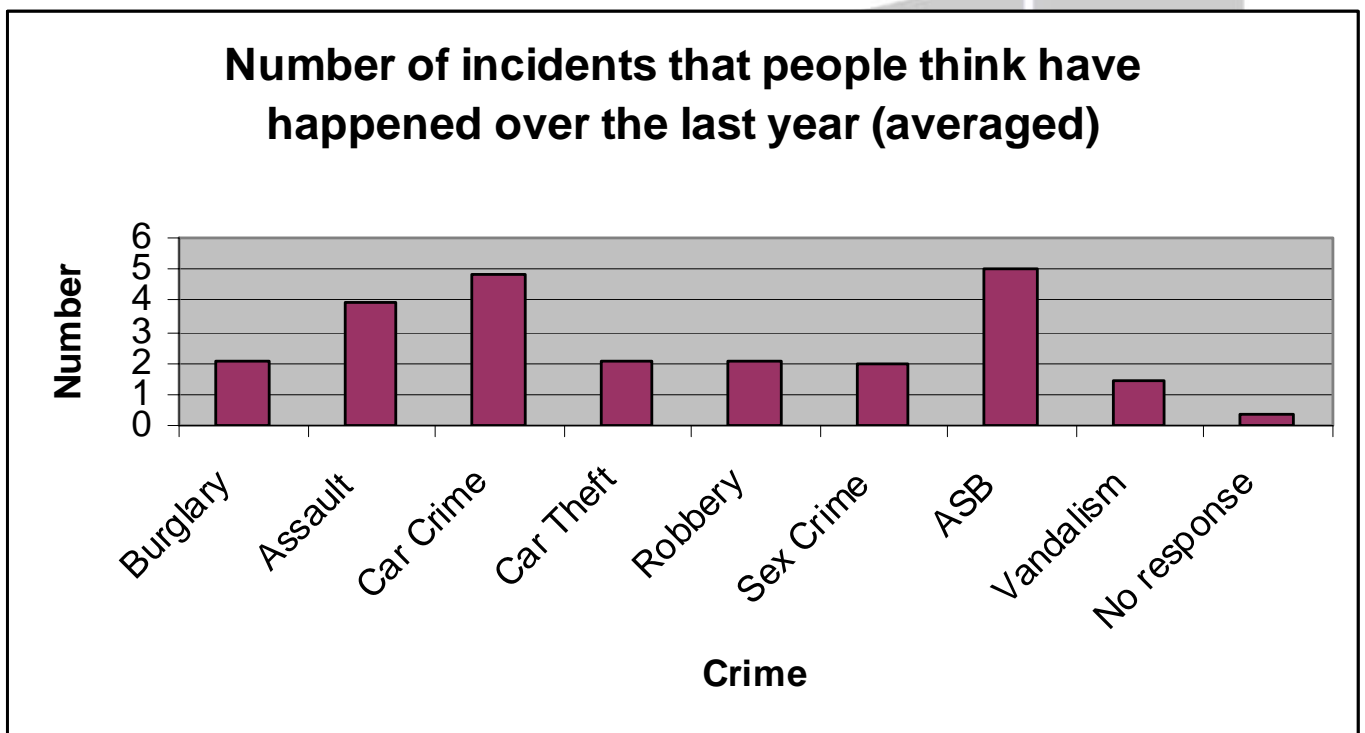


Question 3: What if anything, do you think has made a difference in the last year?

Where people replied "other", answer was "cleaner estate"

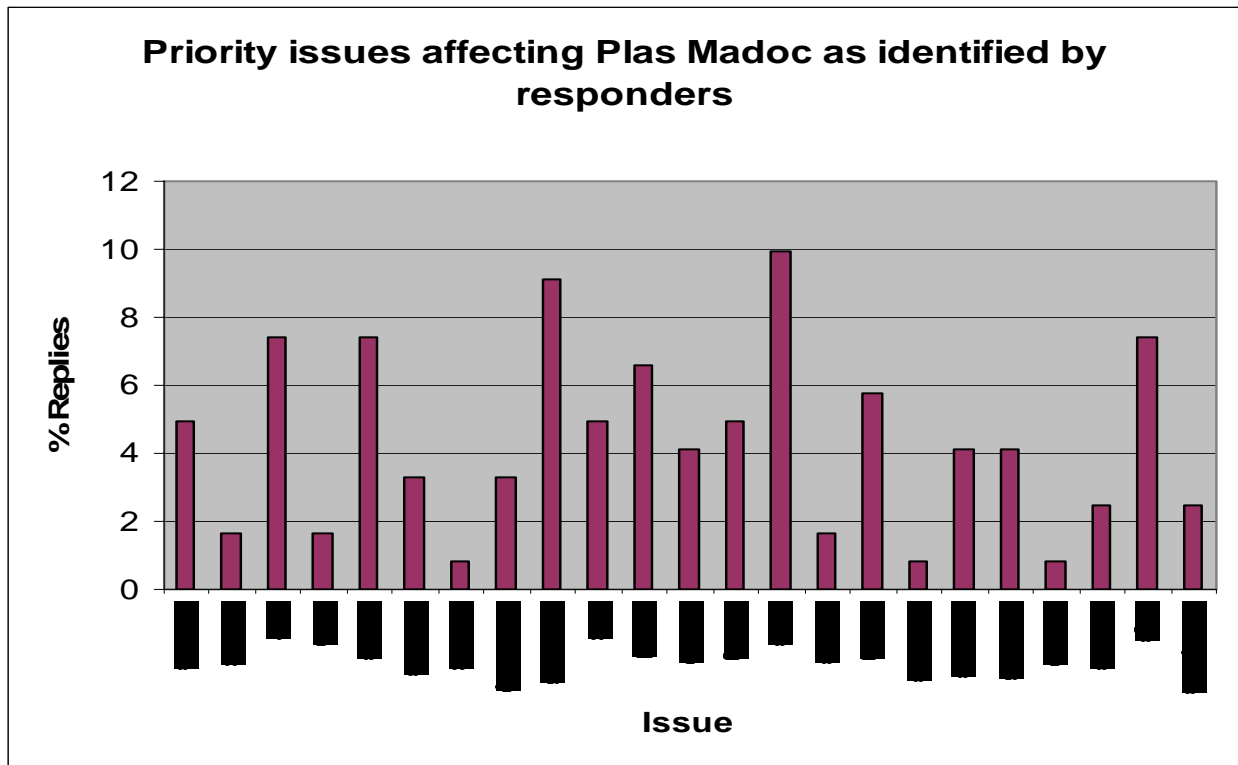
Question 4: How many incidents of the following crimes do you think have taken place in Plas Madoc since October 2005?

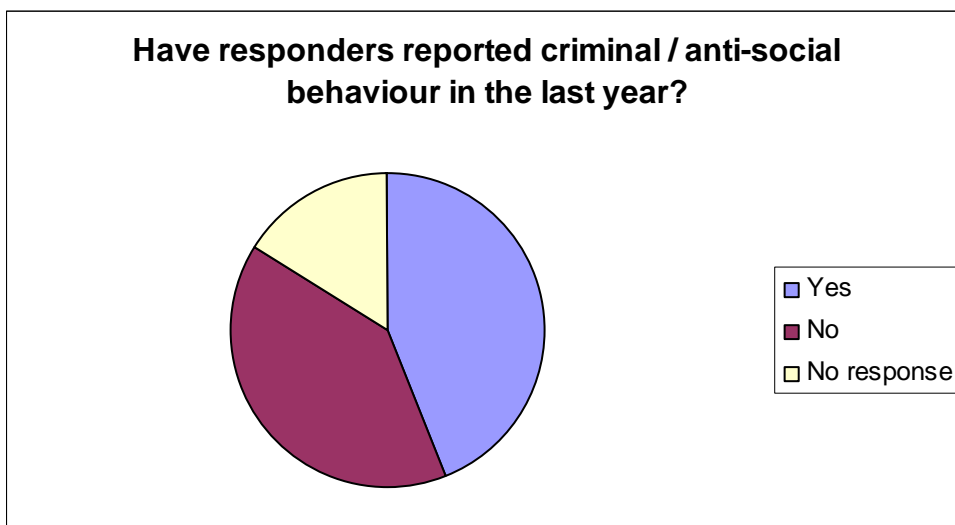

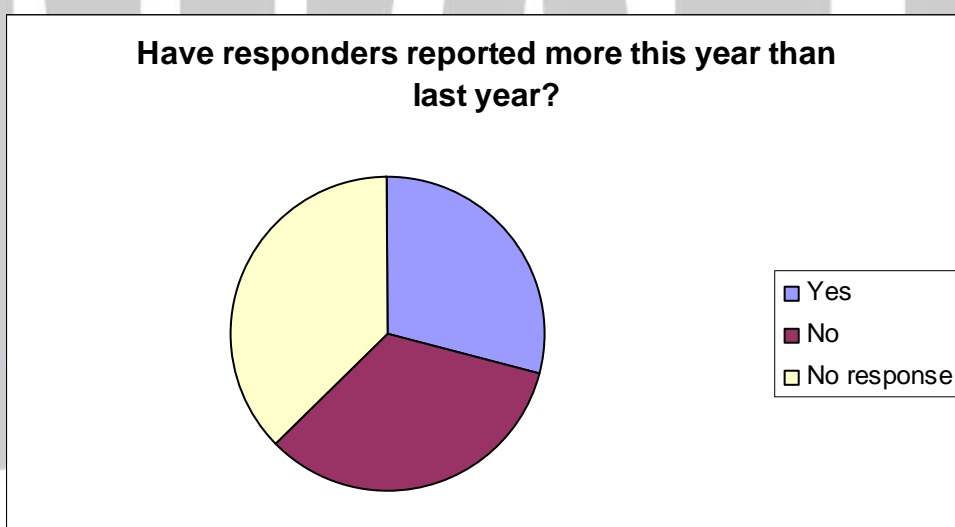

If YES, have you reported more than last year?



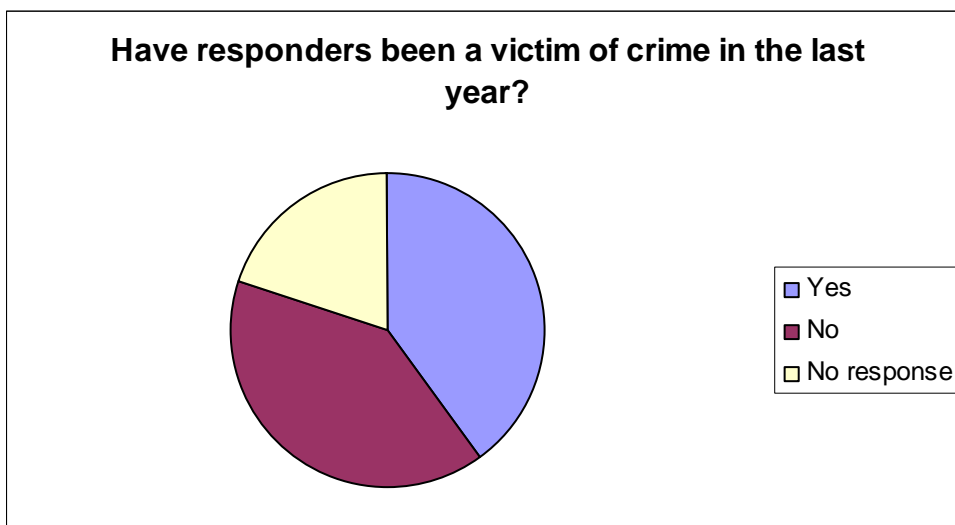
29% of people said they had reported more than they did last year

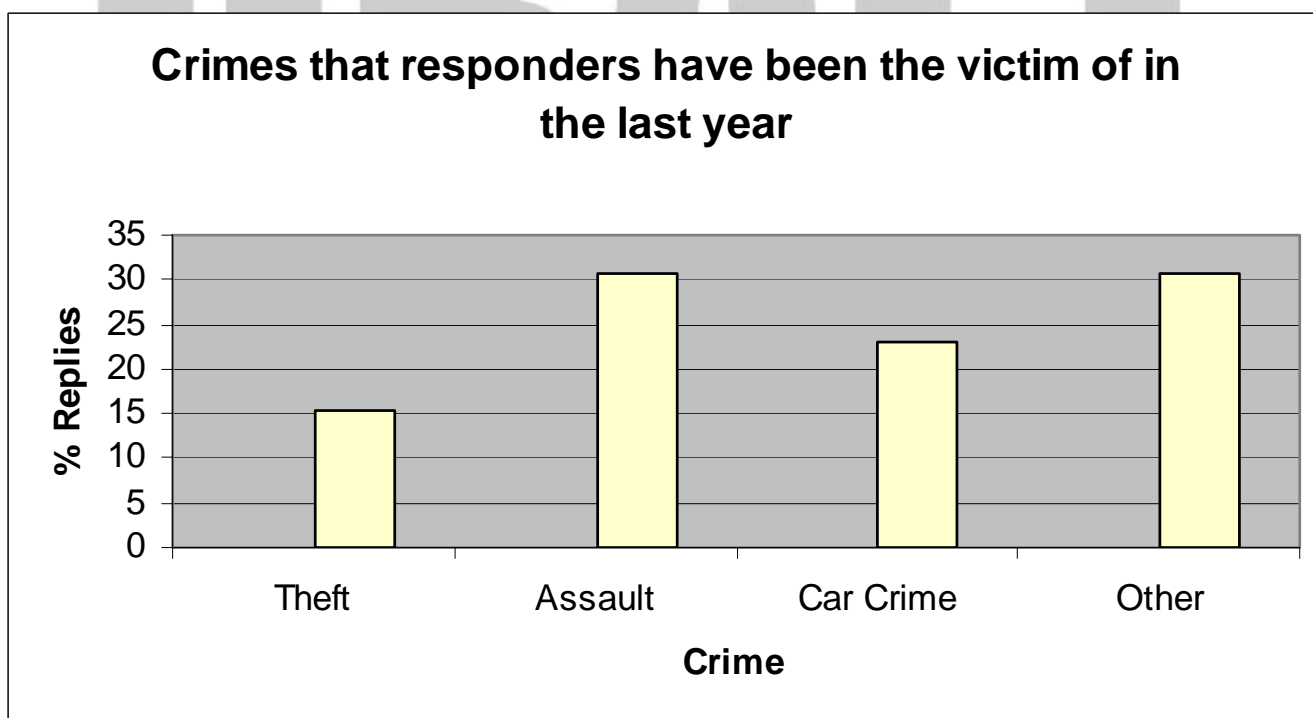
There were only 7 responses to this question – where comments were made about “Police attitude” people didn’t seem to think that the Police “cared”.

Question 8; Have you been a victim of crime in the last year?

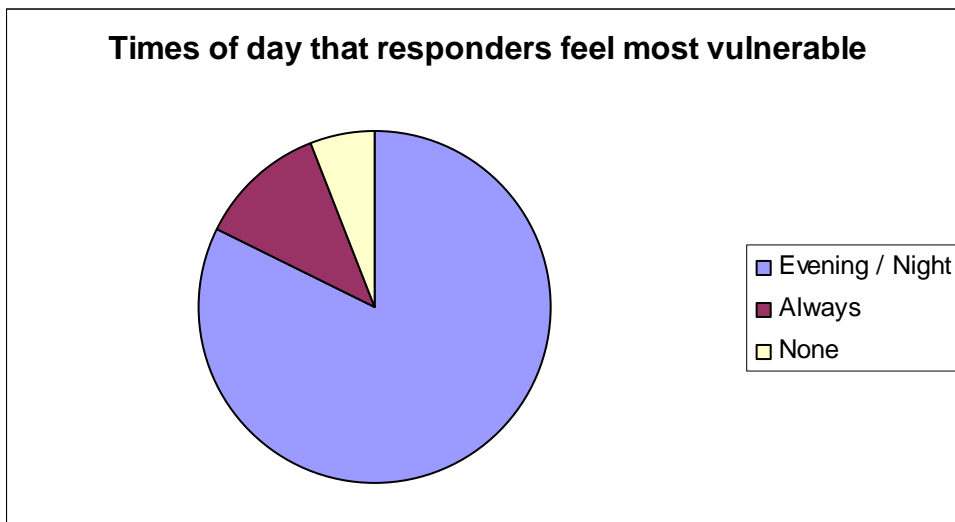


People from the Estate have been the victims of the following crimes

A total of 13 crimes were identified

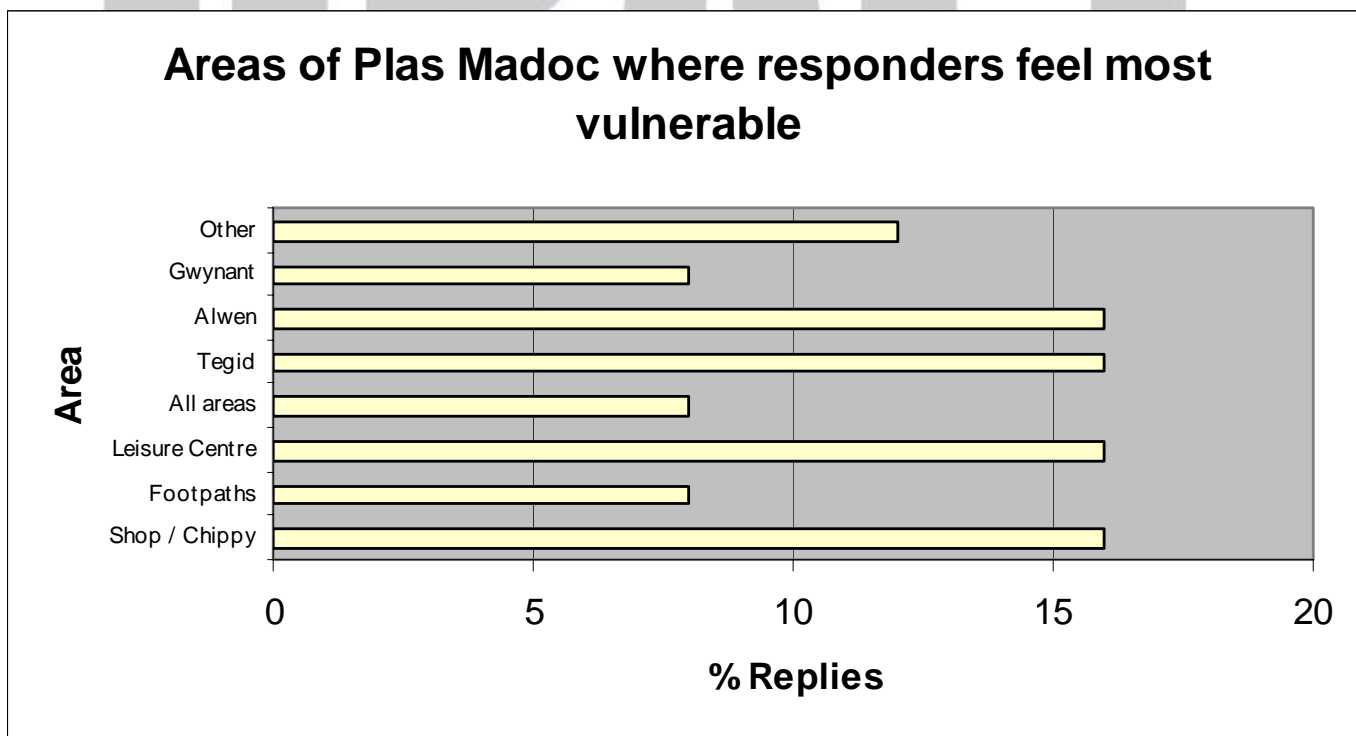


Question 9 : What time of day do you feel most vulnerable and why?



The most common reason given for the “why” was lack of lighting, with one person stating it was due to youths congregating.

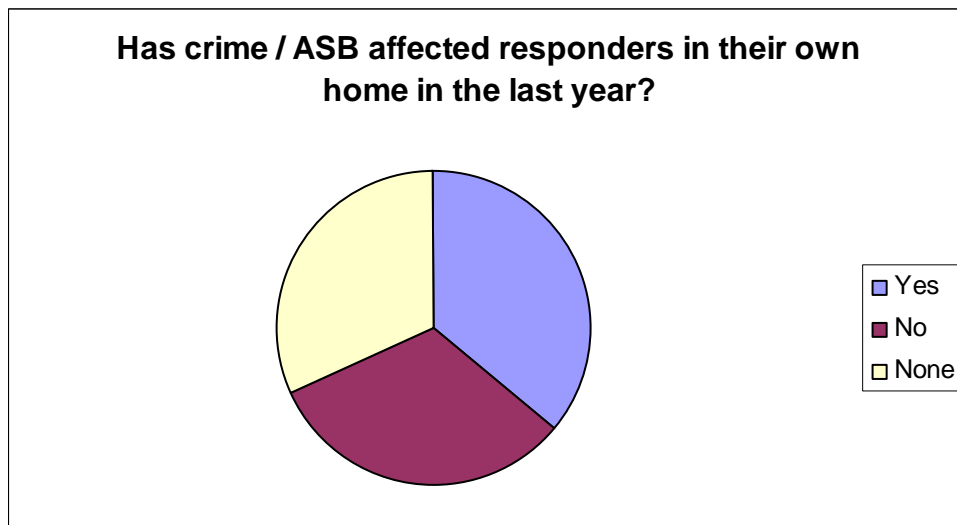
Question 10 : What areas of the estate make you feel most vulnerable and why?



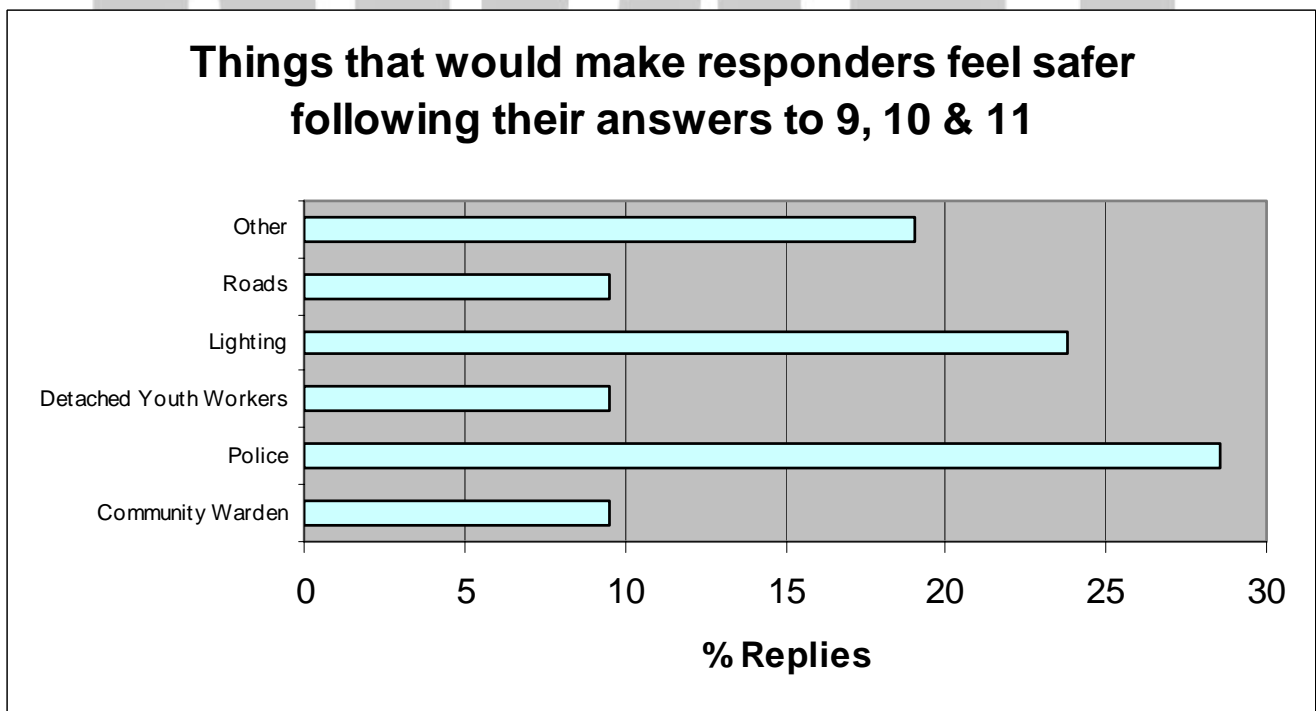
Reasons given for the answers were as follows:-

The Leisure Centre – due to poor lighting

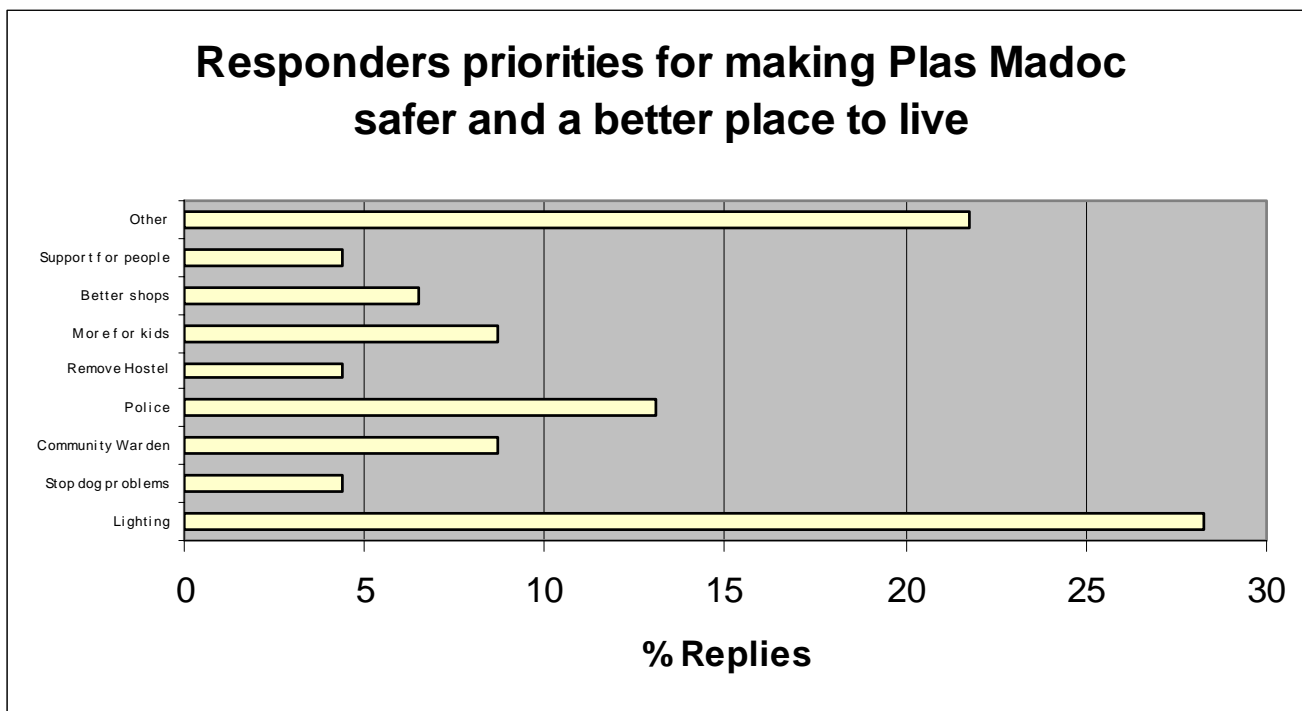
Question 11 : Has crime / ASB affected you in your own home in the last year?
